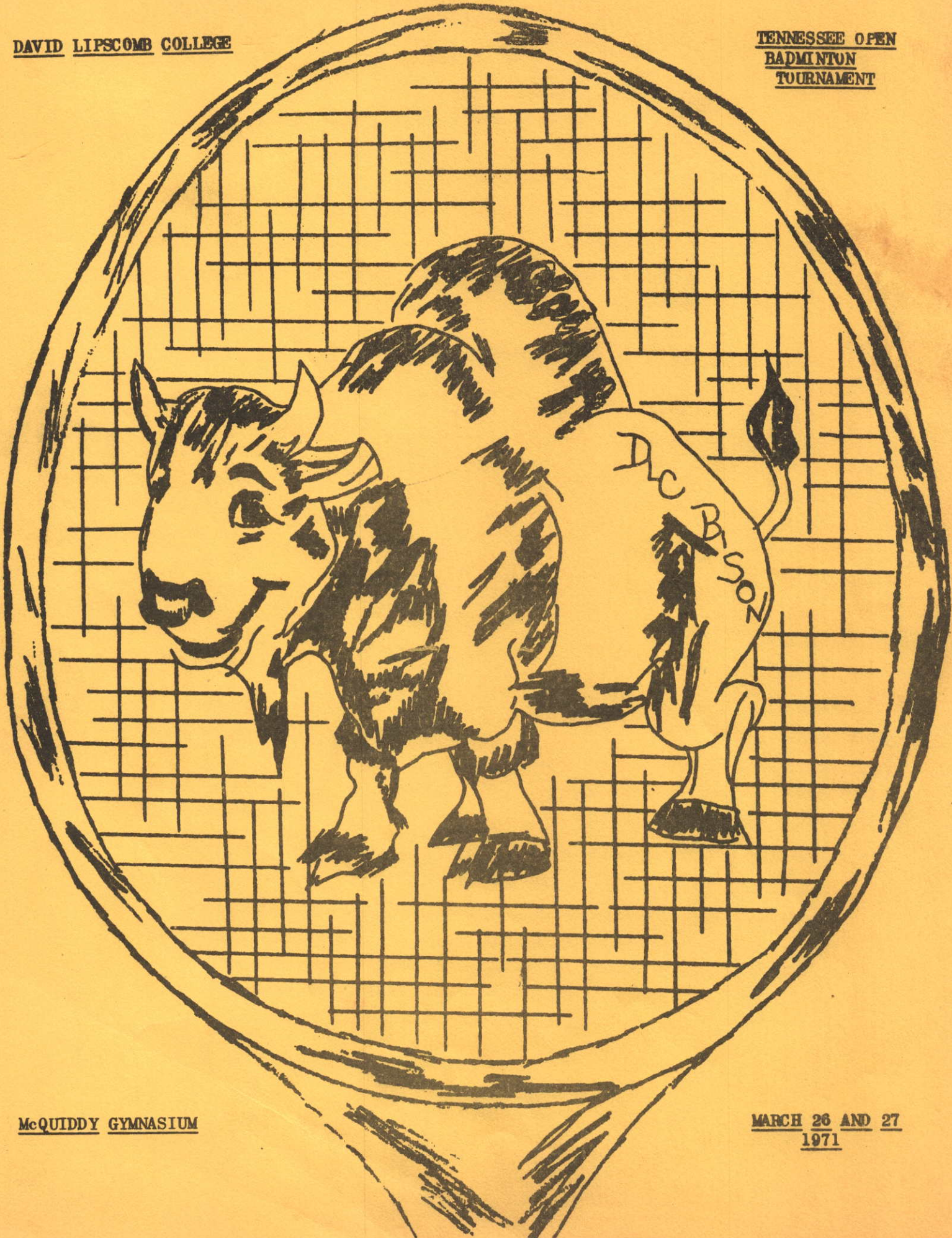

TENNESSEE STATE OPEN BADMINTON TOURNAMENT

March 26 and 27, 1971


General Information

(In addition to that given on the entry form)

1. All matches except ladies singles shall be the best 2 of 3 games to 15 points. Ladies singles shall be the best 2 of 3 games to 11 points. Play will be conducted according to the official rules of the A. B. A.
2. Note new "woodshot rule." "It is a fault:-----If the shuttle be held on the racket (i.e. caught or slung) during the execution of a stroke; or if the shuttle be hit twice in succession by the same player with two strokes; or if the shuttle be hit by a player and his partner successively." Interpretation: "Every shot is good--except a sling or carry.
3. Players must be ready to play within ten minutes after match is called or a forfeit will be declared.
4. Please take no longer than ten minutes for warm-up for first round matches and no longer than five minutes for subsequent matches.
5. Before match, get game bird and warm-up bird from scorers table and, if new bird is needed during match, bring old bird to scorers table. Report results of match immediately after it is completed.
6. All those not playing in matches please remain in the balcony or behind scorers table on main floor.
7. All matches, or possible matches, are numbered and you may determine the approximate time you play from the set of brackets available to each participant at the scorers table.
