HISTORIC FARMINGTON

Dating from 1640, it was originally purchased from the Tunxis Indians by a group of early Colonists. Containing over 100 homes dating prior to 1835 the original Village of Farmington was declared an historic district by an act of legislature. It contains some of the most beautifully restored seventeenth, eighteenth and nineteenth century homes and public buildings in the nation. Miss Porter's School, founded in 1843, owns several of these fine homes.

MUSEUMS: The Stanley-Whitman House, built around 1660 is the finest example of a 17th century home in New England. The Hillstead Museum contains many masterpieces by Monet, Manet and Degas.

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS




