#### HIGH SCHOOL TOURNAMENT RULES

#### Specification for High School Standard Facilities

- For CIF Team and Individual competition, and High School State Championship Finals, the minimum height shall be 20 feet.
- 2. The entire height shall be entirely free of obstructions over the court area.
- 3. Subject to specific exception, the High School Court Official Chairperson may vary these requirements.
  - 3.1 Ground rules will be enforced for those permanent obstructions below 20 feet.
  - 3.2 All movable obstructions below 20 feet must be removed.
- If the court facility does not meet the minimum requirements or approval from the High School Court Official Chair, an appropriate facility or neutral site must be used.

#### Conduct of Tournaments

- A Referee shall be appointed for all sanctioned CIF Tournaments, CIF Team and Individual Playoffs.
  - 1.1 The Referee shall be in overall charge of the tournament.
  - 1.2 The Referee or a deputy shall always be present in the facility during play.
- The High School Court Official Chairman shall appoint the Referee for all the sanctioned High School Tournament and CIF Team and Individual Championships.
- The appointed Referee shall be assigned from a pool of referees who are not affiliated with schools competing.
- 4. The duties of the Referee includes:
  - 4.1 Ensuring that the conduct of the tournament is in accordance with the Laws of badminton, the Rules of Regulation of CIF, SCBA, USA Badminton and other regulations pertinent to the tournament.
  - 4.2 Overall control of court officials.

#### ASSIGNMENT OF REFEREE OR UMPIRES

Contact the High School Court Official Chairperson a minimum of three (3) weeks prior to the event.

#### **CLOTHING REGULATIONS**

In applying the following regulations, the decision of the Referee at each event shall be final. Players failing to comply will be asked to change, remove the inappropriate articles or default the match.

- In order to ensure attractive presentation of badminton, all clothing worn by players at high school events shall be acceptable badminton clothing and it is recommended that doubles partners wear the same colors.
- For the purpose of these Regulations, articles of clothing shall be defined as anything worn or carried by a player during play, except racket, and including, but not limited to, pullovers, shirts, shorts, skirts, socks, shoes, headbands, wristbands. Caps or visors are not allowed.
- In all events, Regulation regarding color and advertisement apply only to clothing worn during play. Headbands or wristbands must be of one solid color not more than 1 inch wide.
- Color of players clothing: In all sanctioned team/individual events, including league
  play each article of clothing may be any color or combination as established by the
  team. T-shirts or collared shirts with sleeves are required. Tank tops are not allowed.
- 5. Design and lettering of clothing:
  - 5.1 Shirts may carry the name, logo or team motto of the school represented.
  - 5.2 The name of players, school or team motto may be placed on the front and/or back of the shirt.
- Emblems of advertisements or commercial content may be no larger than 10 centimeters in height on any clothing.
- 7. All shirts are to be tucked in during play.
- 8. All shorts are not to be cut longer than the top of the players knees.


