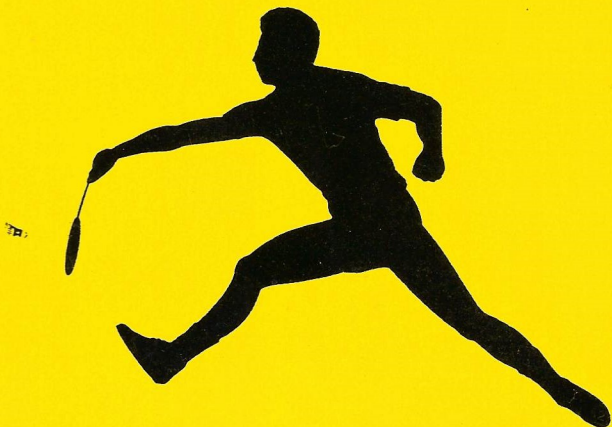

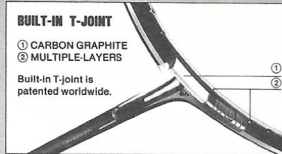

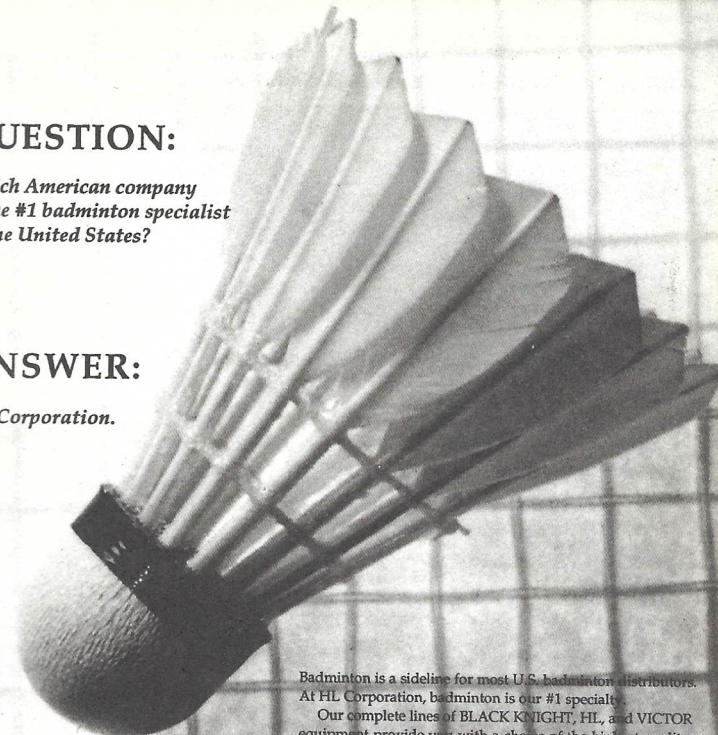
- 1. WHAT IS THE MAILING ADDRESS FOR THE SCBA?**
