A Line judge is an important and essential part of the game.

#1...We are "Court Officials", same as the Umpire, and we play an important role in determining fair play during the match. We work as a coordinated unit with the umpire to this end. The Line Judges also makes the Umpire's job easier and more effective.

It is our job as Line Judges to be impartial (not to be influenced, distracted or intimidated by any team, player, coach or spectator) in making a call. The Line Judge is solely responsible for the line assigned. We work hard to attain high skill levels and to look, act and be professional in our work on the court. Line Judge clinics and training will be provided.

As a US Open Line Judge, entry to the US Open is no charge. We provide a "Court Official" T-shirt for all Line Judges as well as meals, snacks and drinks. Did I mention you have the best seat in the house for the game and also get to watch the best badminton players from all over the world!

### Starting a Badminton Club

- 1. Assemble a group, 8-16 or more players, interested in playing Badminton on a regular basis.
- Choose a "Leader" who has the time and interest in heading up a new club and who will be responsible for:
  - A. Locating a facility or gym where the club members can play.
    - 1) High School, Junior College, or College gym; Park and Recreation facility; Private facility.
    - Check required space needed for badminton courts (2-3 courts suggested Min.)
       Width 20', Length 44', Minimum ceiling height 20"- 25'
  - B. Negotiating an agreement with the person in charge of the gym or facility:
    - Rental or fee for use of the facility (per use basis or per player charge)
       Park and Recreation facilities may be more available at a lesser cost.
    - Check if insurance is required or a waver of liability for each player is needed.
       The USAB can provide cheap liability insurance for clubs and tournaments.
    - 3) Check facility if badminton court lines are already on gym floor.
      - a) Make arrangement to have court lines painted on floor.
      - b) Use colored vinyl tape (1" to 1.5") for temporary court lines.
    - 4) Check to see if badminton posts or standards are available. If not, then
      - a) Use anchors in walls to attach the nets and a ratcheting device to tighten.
      - b) Buy free standing standards (ex. Yonex)
      - c) Make free standing standards with wheels (contact SCBA for designs)
    - 5) Have someone responsible to open and CLOSE the facility, and to set up and take down nets and standards.
    - 6) Will the club provide shuttles to buy or will everyone bring their own?
  - C. Membership dues:
    - 1) Will there be a fee to join the club?
    - 2) Will there be a cost to play badminton on a per time basis or monthly fee basis etc
    - 3) Who will collect fees and be responsible for accounting

### **History of Badminton**

#### Origins of the Game

The sport of badminton has its origins in ancient civilizations in Europe and Asia. The ancient game known as battledore (bat or paddle) and shuttlecock probably originated more than 2000 years ago. In the 1600s Battledore and Shuttlecock was an upper class pastime in England and many European countries. Battledore and Shuttlecock was simply two people hitting a shuttlecock backwards and forwards with a simple bat as many times as they could without allowing it to hit the ground.

A contemporary form of badminton - a game called 'Poon', was played in India in the 1800s where a net was introduced and players hit the shuttlecock across the net. British officers in the mid 1800's took this game back to England and it was introduced as a game for the guests of the Duke of Beaufort at his stately home 'Badminton' in Gloucestershire, England where it became popular.

In March 1898, the first Open Tournament was held at Guildford the first 'All England' Championships were held the following year. Denmark, the USA and Canada became ardent followers of the game during the 1930s.

#### IBF Established

Then in 1934, the International Badminton Federation was formed, with the initial members including England, Wales, Ireland, Scotland, Denmark, Holland, Canada, New Zealand and France, with India joining as an affiliate in 1936. The first major IBF tournament was the Thomas Cup (world men's team championships) in 1948. Since then, the number of world events has increased with the addition of the Über Cup (women's team), World Championships (individual events), Sudirman Cup (mixed team), World Junior Championships, World Senior Championships, and the World Grand Prix Finals.

Beginning in 2004 the IBF moved its office away from England for the first time in its 70 year history to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, changed its name to the **Badminton World Federation** (BWF), and introduced the 21 point rally scoring system. Along with these dramatic changes the BWF decentralized forming five Continental Confederations: Europe, Asia, Africa, Oceania, and Pan America. Badminton is now one of the most popular sports in the world with 164 registered countries and over 150 million competitors.

#### Olympic Games Sport - 1992

Badminton is a relatively new Olympic Games sport. After being a demonstration sport in Munich in 1972, badminton became an Olympic sport in Barcelona in 1992 with the singles and doubles disciplines introduced for the first time in the Olympic Games. In Atlanta in 1996, a mixed doubles event was included and this is the only mixed doubles event in all of the Olympic sports. Only five countries have won the gold medals since its introduction in 1992 - China (8), Indonesia (5) and Korea (5) and Denmark (1).


